

IMPORTANT NOTICE

UPLOADING OF PROVISIONAL ANSWER KEY AND SUBMISSION OF CHALLENGES

The KPL recruitment Computer Based Test (CBT) for the notified posts was conducted on **21.06.2026** at various examination centres.

The **Provisional Answer Key(s)** has been uploaded on the examination portal on **29.06.2026**. Candidates may log in using their Registration Number/User ID and Password to view their response sheet and provisional answer key.

Submission of Challenges

Candidates who wish to challenge any question(s) and/or answer key(s) may submit their representations through the online challenge module available in their login dashboard.

The challenge facility shall remain available from **29.06.2026 to 03.07.2026 up to 05:00 PM**.

No representation received after **05:00 PM on 03.07.2026** shall be entertained under any circumstances. Challenges submitted through e-mail, post, grievance portal, or any other mode will not be accepted.

Challenge Fee

1. A fee of **Rs.100/- (Rupees One Hundred only) per question challenged** shall be payable online through the prescribed payment gateway.
2. The fee shall be refunded only in respect of those challenges which are found to be valid and accepted by the Subject Matter Experts (SMEs).
3. The decision of the Subject Matter Experts regarding the validity of challenges shall be final and binding.

Procedure for Raising Challenges

1. Login to the candidate portal using your Registration Number/User ID and Password.
2. Navigate to the **"Answer Key Challenge"** tab.
3. Select the question(s) proposed to be challenged, provide detailed justification/reasons for each challenge, and upload supporting documentary evidence, if any, in the prescribed format.
4. Make payment of the applicable challenge fee.
5. Submit the challenge and download/print the acknowledgement for future reference.

Important Instructions

1. Candidates may note that the sequence of questions and answer options displayed in the challenge module may differ from the sequence seen during the actual examination.
2. The provisional answer key is made available only for the purpose of self-verification and submission of challenges.
3. Candidates are advised to carefully examine the provisional answer key before submitting any challenge.

4. Challenges without proper justification or supporting evidence may not be considered.
5. Multiple challenges against the same question by the same candidate may not be entertained.

Evaluation of Challenges

1. All challenges received within the stipulated period shall be examined by independent Subject Matter Experts.
2. If any challenge is found to be valid, the provisional answer key shall be revised accordingly.
3. If a question is found to be incorrect, ambiguous, or having more than one correct answer, the matter shall be dealt with as per the approved examination evaluation policy.
4. The decision of the Subject Matter Experts and the Examination Authority shall be final and no further correspondence shall be entertained.

Publication of Final Answer Key

After completion of the expert review process, the **Final Answer Key** shall be published on the examination portal.

Challenge to Final Answer Key

No challenge or representation against the Final Answer Key shall be entertained. The result shall be processed on the basis of the Final Answer Key published by the Examination Authority.

Candidates are advised to visit the examination portal regularly for updates regarding final answer key, result declaration and other examination-related information. Individual communications may not be sent separately in this regard.
